

Admission Procedure for the Academic Year 2012/2013

Open Days: 13 October 2011 and 21 February 2012, starting at 2pm at the College

Entrance Examinations: 24 and 26 April 2012

Candidates need to sit the College entrance examination in English, Mathematics, Czech and a non-verbal reasoning test (Czech Programme) or English, Mathematics and a non-verbal reasoning test (International Programme) at the College on the date specified. Exams will be set at the level appropriate for the year of entry. Past papers and criteria are available from the Registrar. **Interviews** in English with the Headmaster are also required beforehand.

Entry is possible at:

Year 1 (8. tř. ZŠ, Yr 8 UK) - a full six year Czech secondary school programme or for international students wishing to improve their English and Czech.

Year 2 (9. tř. ZŠ, Yr 9 UK) - international students on PRE IGCSE programme, Czech students with a good level of English.

Year 3 (1.ročník gymnázií, Yr 10 UK) - Czech students on a four year secondary school programme. International or Czech students on a two year IGCSE programme.

Year 4 (2. ročník gymnázií, Yr11 UK) - Czech and international students with a very high level of English for a year's preparation course for IB.

Year 5 (3. ročník gymnázií, Yr12 UK) - Czech and international students for the two year IB Programme. A high level of academic English is required.

Expected number of successful candidates:

The College is looking to admit into Year 1 up to 40 boys and girls of appropriate calibre, of whom approximately 80% should be of Czech nationality.

Admission criteria:

Candidates need to have satisfied the Headmaster that they are proficient and fluent enough in English to be able to understand lessons taught entirely in English. Reports from candidates' previous schools need to show that their academic achievement, behaviour and attendance are satisfactory or better. Candidates need to reach a sufficient standard of achievement in the three entrance examination papers to satisfy the College's academic requirements.

Aptitude test:

To help you make the final decision, the College provides an aptitude test before the actual entrance examination. The test will be held on 1 March 2012 between 9.00 and 10.30 a.m. and will consist of three short papers: English, (Czech language in the Czech Programme), Maths and IQ. This aptitude test is not an examination and is not obligatory, and no marks or grades will be published. It will, however, enable us to advise you on the suitability of your child for the College, in case you have any doubts about whether your child will succeed at the College. If you would like your child to sit the test, please let us know before 24 February 2012 at the latest.

After the test, you may contact the Registrar, Mrs Rozkošná, who will be able to give you information and advice about the entrance examinations on Tuesday 24 and Thursday 26 April 2012.

The entrance exam invitation and further details will be sent out well in advance (in the beginning of April). We would like to remind you that you have to fill in the official application form (SEVT) in your **child's primary** school and hand it to us by 15 March 2012 at the latest.
