

# Prague International Schools Tennis Tournament Saturday, September 20<sup>th</sup> 2008

The first event of this school year's chain of competitions is going to be **The Prague International Schools Tennis Tournament** under our organization. It takes place in a nice and cosy tennis club with 4 clay courts (antuka surface, French Open type) on the weekend of September 20<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup>. There are two categories – singles ladies, and singles gentlemen, regardless of age. Both victors will be awarded trophies, all semi-finalists diplomas, and the runner-ups small statues and diplomas. If the last year's victors and finalists take part again they will be seeded No.1 and 2, respectively. The draw will be done at 8:50 on the spot in the presence of the players. Depending on the lateness of the semi-final matches, the final matches will be played either on Saturday evening or on Sunday at an agreed time. The tennis club offers changing rooms with showers and a club canteen serving a range of refreshments. A training wall is available for warming up. The players are encouraged to wear tennis outfit and they must wear tennis shoes. Rough sole shoes are not allowed on the courts. The appointment of all people involved in the event is on **Saturday, September 20<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 a.m.** in the car park next to the *Dobřichovice* railway station. Those who choose to go by train are to take train number 9972 that leaves *Praha Smíchov* at **8:04**, arrival at *Dobřichovice* at **8:26**. Access by car is along R4 Strakonická, exit to road number 10 in Jíloviště, direction *Všenory*, *Dobřichovice*. The distance from the edge of Prague is about 20km.
